

Urgent appeal to raise a further £200,000 for Beatriz's cancer treatment in Rome



Beatriz, or 'Bibi', is 6 years old and her favourite things are drawing, dancing, putting on fashion shows and making YouTube videos with her big sister.

She was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma in 2018 when she was just 2 years old and over the last four years has received extensive treatment both in the UK and in Spain which had successfully got Bibi into remission. Sadly, in February 2023 scans showed new areas of disease.

Bibi's family are urgently fundraising to raise a further £200,000 so she can enrol on a promising clinical trial using engineered T cells called GD2 CART in Rome without delay. This trial is currently not available on the NHS.

Funds raised will go towards helping Beatriz and her family. If Beatriz no longer needs the funds or is in remission five years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through Solving Kids' Cancer UK's activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Beatriz, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further.
