

# Freya is fighting a life-threatening cancer



Freya is a sweet, funny and caring seven-year-old who loves nothing more than spending time with her identical twin Alice.

In December 2022, Freya was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma, an aggressive childhood cancer that has a 40-50% chance of long-term survival at diagnosis. After 15 months of treatment, in March 2024, Freya's end-of-treatment scans showed the cancer had returned.

Treating relapsed neuroblastoma successfully is particularly challenging and treatment options available on the NHS are limited. The family are fundraising should Freya need potentially life-saving treatment to get her back into remission that is not available through the NHS.
