

Jessica is fighting a life-threatening cancer

Jessica is 2 years old. She is the sweetest and kindest little girl who loves animals, Peppa Pig and adores spending time with and playing with her cousin.

> In April 2021, at just a year old, Jessica was diagnosed with highrisk neuroblastoma, an aggressive childhood cancer that has a 40-50% chance of long-term survival at diagnosis.

Jessica's family are fundraising for further treatment, either to get their daughter into remission or to try and keep the cancer away if her frontline treatment does go to plan.

Funds raised will go towards helping Jessica and her family. If Jessica no longer needs the funds or is in remission five years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through Solving Kids' Cancer UK's activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Jessica, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further.
