

# Jessica is fighting a life-threatening cancer



Jessica is 2 years old. She is the sweetest and kindest little girl who loves animals, Peppa Pig and adores spending time with and playing with her cousin.

In April 2021, at just a year old, Jessica was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma, an aggressive childhood cancer that has a 40-50% chance of long-term survival at diagnosis.

Jessica's family are fundraising for further treatment, either to get their daughter into remission or to try and keep the cancer away if her frontline treatment does go to plan.
