



# Teddy is fighting a life-threatening cancer



Teddy is a 3-year-old from West Sussex who is obsessed with anything to do with trains! He loves riding trains, going to the station to see the trains, playing with his train set and watching Thomas & Friends.

In July 2022 Teddy was diagnosed with high-risk neuroblastoma, an aggressive childhood cancer that has a 40-50% chance of long-term survival at diagnosis.

Teddy's family are fundraising for further treatment, either to get their son into remission or to try and keep the cancer away if his frontline treatment does go to plan.

Funds raised will go towards helping Teddy and his family. If Teddy no longer needs the funds or is in remission five years post the end of successful treatment, the funds will be used to support other children and families affected by neuroblastoma through Solving Kids' Cancer UK's activities. For children with high-risk neuroblastoma, like Teddy, the survival rate is much lower than other childhood cancers. Upon relapse, this rate reduces even further.
